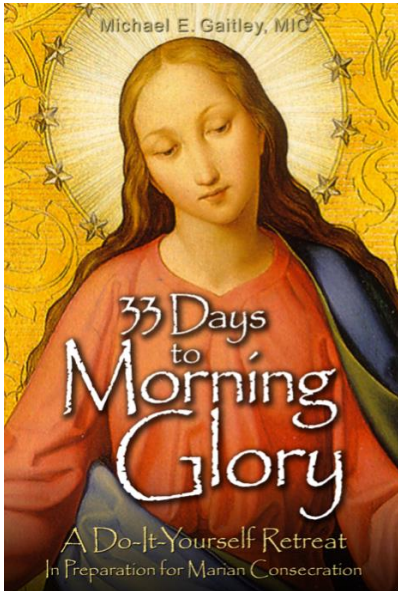


Want to Grow in Holiness, But Too Busy?

Join us as we begin a 33-day preparation for Marian Consecration, starting on Monday, April 10th and ending on Saturday, May 13th- the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.

For six weeks, we'll individually read about and reflect on four great Marian giants: St. Louis de Montfort, St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. Mother Teresa, and Pope Saint John Paul II. They'll teach us the secrets to drawing closer to the Heart of Jesus through the Heart of Mary.

Cathedral Parish has ordered 250 copies of the magazine book "33 Days to Morning Glory" by popular author and speaker, Fr. Michael Gaitley, MIC, who spoke at the last Eucharistic Congress on March 25th in Jacksonville. The books will be available for free at the doors of the Cathedral on Palm Sunday Weekend- April 8th and 9th. Please take only one per family. If you are interested in doing this Marian Consecration for the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, make sure you get your copy early as they may run out. **If there are no copies available when you attend Mass that weekend, you can order Fr. Fr. Michael Gaitley, MIC, has a series of six 30-minute videos that bring our individual reflections into a clear and live-able focus for this Marian Consecration. Cathedral Parishioners can access these videos for free through our parish's subscription with "Formed.org". You will register with the parish code (7ef31e) and your e-mail address. Go to the bottom of the webpage and click "Content List". "33 Days to Morning Glory" is listed under "Programs" and "Hearts Afire Parish Based Programs".

Again, the 33 days begin on April 10th for the May 13th Consecration. But, you can choose to make this consecration at other times also. The schedule of other dates for consecration are listed in the book. We hope to do this consecration again in the Fall ending of October 11th- the Feast of Our Lady of La Leche, as a parish. In the Fall, we hope to meet weekly and watch the videos together.

As a parish, we will join together on Saturday, May 13, 2017, in the Cathedral at 12:00 Noon for a special prayer service in honor of Our Lady of Fatima and the 100th Anniversary. We will pray the Morning Glory Consecration Prayer together at that time. Please mark your calendars and plan on attending- whether you do the consecration now or not.
