



❖ Parish Religious Education is open for registration!

Parish Religious Education is open for registration for the 2019-2020 school year! Calendars and Registration forms for general religious education classes, as well as Sacrament Preparation classes, are available on the parish website, www.thefirstparish.org, under the "Faith Formation" tab. Reception of any sacraments for children in the diocese of St. Augustine requires two years of general religious education. So in order for 2nd graders to receive their First Communion, they need to be enrolled in Religious Education in 1st grade as well. The same rule applies to Confirmation in 8th grade: students will need to be enrolled in 7th grade in order to receive the sacrament in 8th grade.

❖First Friday Art Walk Recital, August 2, 6 p.m. will feature organist Bruce Xu

The First Friday Art Walk Recital at the Cathedral Basilica on August 2 will feature young organ recitalist Mr. Bruce Xu.


Bruce Xu, from Sloatsburg, New York, was introduced to the grand pipe organ and the Protestant Church in his local Sloatsburg United Methodist Church. Within a month, he started organ lessons at age 9.

Since then, Bruce has continued to uncover his passion for playing the pipe organ. Getting more serious with his study, he traveled south to the high school program of the University of North Carolina School of the Arts, where he studied organ performance and sang with the Cantata Singers. Needing some time off campus, Bruce took the role of Music Intern under his teacher at Augsburg Lutheran Church in downtown Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

In the Spring/Summer of 2017, Bruce won 1st prize in six organ competitions, including the AGO Quimby/RCYO Regional Competition (Jacksonville, FL). As the winner of the monumental regional competition, Bruce was granted a spot as a performer in the 2018 National Convention of the American Guild of Organists held in Kansas City, MO. Bruce continues his organ studies with Dr. Matthew Lewis at the Pre-College division of The Juilliard School in New York City.

On August 2, Bruce will be playing the works of Conte, Franck, Fauré, Duruflé and others.

As usual, this recital which begins at 6 p.m. (doors open at 5:30 p.m.) is open to the public and is free of charge. Cathedral Parish Parking: **TRUE OR FALSE?**

If I have a parish parking permit, I can park in the "Bank of America Lot" any time I want.

FALSE. During bank hours, no parishioner parking is allowed in the westernmost 1/3 of the lot. These spaces are exclusively for parking while banking. Provided there is space available, those with a Cathedral Parish parking permit are allowed to park in the easternmost 2/3 of the "Bank of America lot" for any "scheduled" Cathedral services. "Scheduled" events are only the Mass and Confession times published in the bulletin and those events listed in the "This Week in the Parish" column of the bulletin. There is no free parking for any service that is not published in the bulletin such as weddings, funerals, school Masses, etc.



SAINT IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA FEAST – JULY 31



The 16th century was one of great change in Western Europe. This was the period of great exploration and colonization as well as the time of the Reformation. The López family of the Loyola Castle gave birth to a son named Íñigo in 1491. He would go on to serve in the military as a young man, but was injured in a battle with French forces in 1521. During his recovery, Íñigo would find himself reading the lives of Christian saints. He was transformed by these stories that would eventually lead him to found the Society of Jesus, more popularly known as the Jesuits, in 1541.

The Jesuits were committed to be "Servants of the Pope." After their founding they served as missionaries in Europe to preach in the face of the Protestant Reformation. They also served as missionaries in far off lands. Ignatius' *Spiritual Exercises* would become the foundation of spiritual direction for the next 400-plus years in the Church. Today the Jesuits are the largest religious order in the Catholic Church – numbering over 15,000 which include those in formation. Presently, Jesuits serve in 112 nations around the world.

In 2020, the Diocese of St. Augustine will commemorate its Sesquicentennial. During the celebrations, Bishop Estévez will consecrate the Diocese of St. Augustine to Our Lady of La Leche. To prepare for this, Father Hugh Gillespie of the Montfort Fathers will be in the Diocese assisting the faithful in preparation for this Consecration. 
