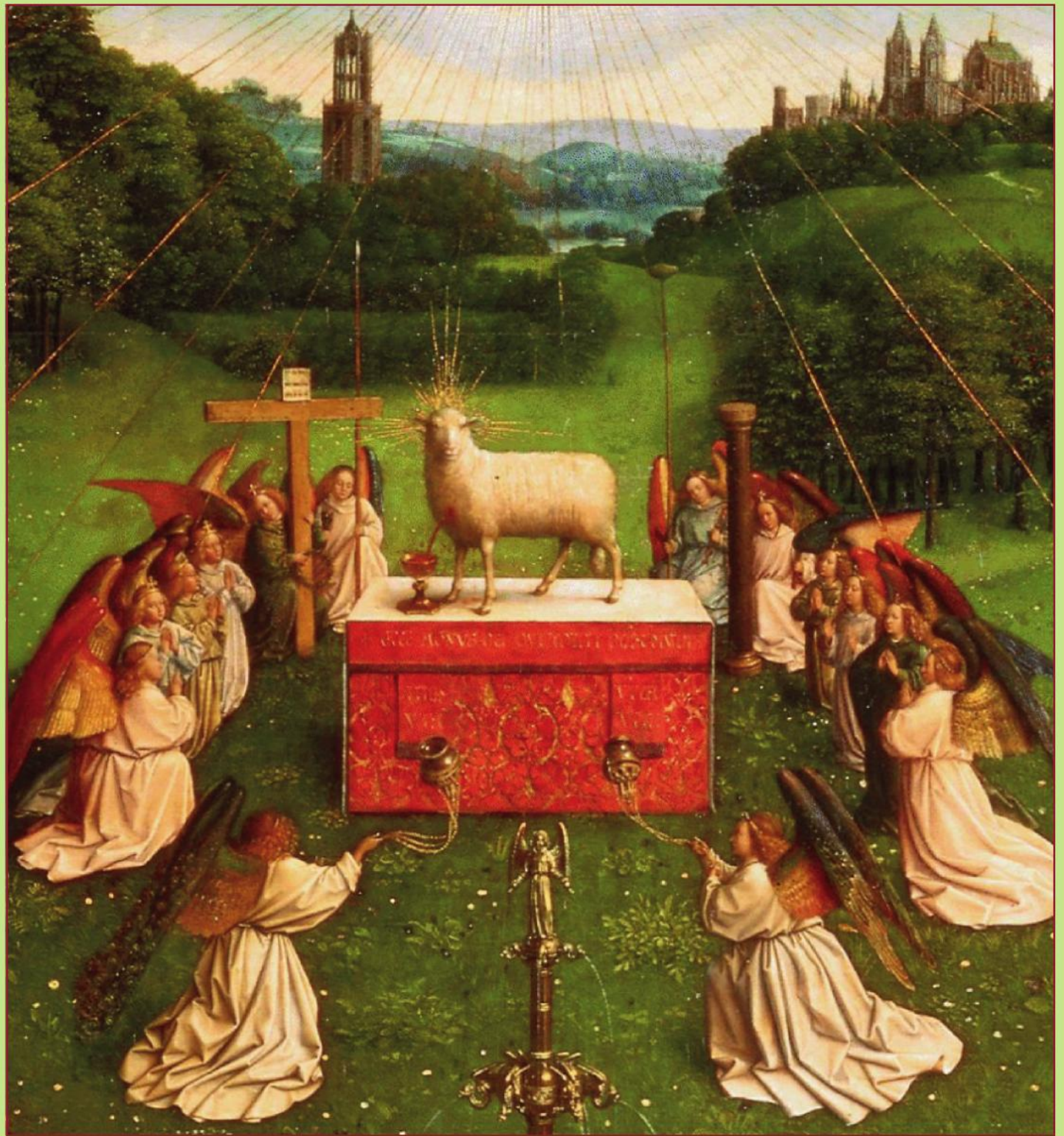

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Most Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist is the Real Presence of Christ – Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior. This is one of the central beliefs of our Catholic Faith. Have you ever wondered why it is not part of the Creeds we pray at Mass?

The primary reason is that when both the Apostles' Creed and the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed were written these were in response to certain beliefs which had been determined to be heresies. The Apostles' Creed emphasizes Jesus' humanity in order to counter the heresy of Gnosticism. The Nicene Creed was developed to state firmly what the Church believed in the face of Arianism. Overall, both Creeds are meant to state the Christian belief in the Blessed Trinity.

No one thought to mention the Church's firm belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist because no one questioned it. The Eucharistic controversies of the 9th and 11th centuries focused the Church to firmly define what it believed about the Eucharist. From there local dioceses began to celebrate feasts and have Eucharistic processions (the forerunners to today's Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ).

Jesus said, *This is my Body* and *This is My Blood*. He who is the Truth cannot and will not deceive us. In the Eucharist we are nourished with the Body and Blood of the One who has saved us. Let us always be thankful for such a gift!

FROM A WORK BY
 THOMAS AQUINAS, PRIEST

(Opusculum 57, in festo Corporis Christi, lect. 1-4)

O precious and wonderful banquet!

Since it was the will of God's only-begotten Son that men should share in his divinity, he assumed our nature in order that by becoming man he might make men gods. Moreover, when he took our flesh he dedicated the whole of its substance to our salvation. He offered his body to God the Father on the altar of the cross as a sacrifice for our reconciliation. He shed his blood for our ransom and purification, so that we might be redeemed from our wretched state of bondage and cleansed from all sin. But to ensure that the memory of so great a gift would abide with us for ever, he left his body as food and his blood as drink for the faithful to consume in the form of bread and wine.

O precious and wonderful banquet, that brings us salvation and contains all sweetness! Could anything be of more intrinsic value? Under the old law it was the flesh of calves and goats that was offered, but here Christ himself, the true God, is set before us as our food. What could be more wonderful than this? No other sacrament has greater healing power; through it sins are purged away, virtues are increased, and the soul is enriched with an abundance of every spiritual gift. It is offered in the Church for the living and the dead, so that what was instituted for the salvation of all may be for the benefit of all. Yet, in the end, no one can fully express the sweetness of this sacrament, in which spiritual delight is tasted at its very source, and in which we renew the memory of that surpassing love for us which Christ revealed in his passion.

It was to impress the vastness of this love more firmly upon the hearts of the faithful that our Lord instituted this sacrament at the Last Supper. As he was on the point of leaving the world to go to the Father, after celebrating the Passover with his disciples, he left it as a perpetual memorial of his passion. It was the fulfilment of ancient figures and the greatest of all his miracles, while for those who were to experience the sorrow of his departure, it was destined to be a unique and abiding consolation.

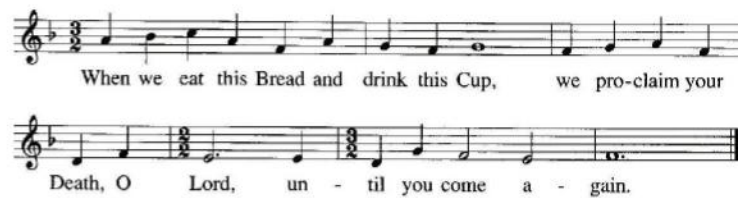

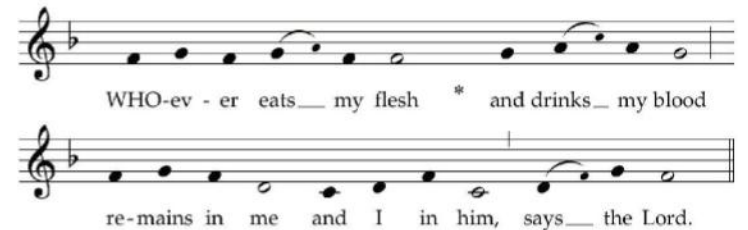
