FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

These Sundays of July, the *Lectionary for Sunday Mass* proclaims some of the parables found in chapter 13 of the *Gospel according to Matthew*. The parables of the Synoptic Gospels (*Matthew, Mark and Luke*) are unlike any other genre of Biblical literature. For those who have studied the great literature of the world, they might be compared to *Aesop's Fables*, but even then the parables of Jesus are so much more.

The Hebrew (Aramaic) word for “parable” is *marshal* which was rendered in Greek, the language of the New Testament, as *parabolē*. The Hebrew means “to be like” while the Greek means “to set beside” as a way to compare. If we listen closely to how Jesus’ parables are introduced in the Gospels we can see why these words were chosen. So often the passage begins with our Savior proclaiming, *The kingdom of God is like...*

And yet, Jesus’ parables are not really comparisons. Rather, they point to something much deeper, much more profound. One modern Biblical scholar defines our Lord’s parables as “a story which employs short, narrative fiction to reference a transcendent symbol.” This simply means that the parables of the Gospels point to something that is beyond our human experience. We might say that they point us to the Mystery of God and the grace He alone bestows.

The parables of the Synoptic Gospels are grace-filled so that they may allow us to see God’s grace, God’s divine life at work – in us, in others, in the world.

Cathedral Early Learning Center (formerly Cathedral Parish Early Education Center) has remained opened through this time of COVID-19 and is committed to ensuring a safe, clean, nurturing environment for children. We are now a year-round school, with open enrollment throughout the year based on availability, with minimal closures. Additionally, we were able to hold our full-time rates nearly the same as last year. We are accepting infants, one-year olds, two-year-olds, three-year-olds, and Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) children.

The VPK program begins August 11, and is designed to prepare children for kindergarten and build the foundation for their educational success. VPK is a free prekindergarten program for 4- and 5-year-olds who reside in Florida. Participating children must be 4 years of age on or before September 1. VPK is a daily program from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., and wraparound care is available beyond the VPK hours.

What is needed, and what we are calling for, is a genuine conversion of heart, a conversion that will compel change, and the reform of our institutions and society. Conversion is a long road to travel for the individual. Moving our nation to a full realization of the promise of liberty, equality, and justice *for all* is even more challenging. However, in Christ we can find the strength and the grace necessary to make that journey.

In this regard, each of us should adopt the words of Pope Francis as our own: let no one “think that this invitation is not meant for him or her.” All of us are in need of personal, ongoing conversion. Our churches and our civic and social institutions are in need of ongoing reform. If racism is confronted by addressing its causes and the injustice it produces, then healing can occur. In that transformed reality, the headlines we see all too often today will become lessons from the past.
