

Grow Faith in a Circle


Join the Cathedral Parish Small Group "Encounter Circle." After weeks of isolation it's a great way to reconnect!

MONSIGNOR JAMES HESLIN

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

On the morning of July 24, 2020, Msgr. James Heslin was called to eternal life by the Good Shepherd. Msgr. Heslin served as the pastor of the Cathedral Parish from 1969-1977. Like his predecessor, Msgr. John Burns, he came to the Cathedral from Saint Paul Parish, Jackson-ville Beach where he had been pastor.

A son of Ireland, he was born in Leitrim on New Year's Eve, 1930. He studied for the priesthood at Saint Patrick's College in Thurles and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of St. Augustine on June 6, 1954. His first assignment was Associate Pastor of Saint Patrick's Church, Miami Beach.

Apparently, Archbishop Joseph Hurley saw Father Heslin's leadership when, in 1961, he named him to be the President of the St. Augustine Foundation. This was the organization of the Diocese that would raise funds for the three projects Hurley had determined would be the Catholic Church's gift to the City of St. Augustine and our 400th Anniversary in 1965: the renovation of the Cathedral, the building of the Prince of Peace Votive Church, and the erection of the Beacon of Faith, the Great Cross. One of Fr. Heslin's responsibilities was to meet with every pastor of the Diocese and tell them the amount of money their parish would be assessed for these projects. Imagine a young priest, not even 10 years ordained, doing this to men who were 20, 30 and 40 years his senior!

Msgr. Heslin was an adamant supporter of the unborn and often preached about the evils of abortion. He was known to help elderly and poor members of this community by taking them himself to shop for groceries and even paying for them from his own wallet. Msgr. Heslin's care for the sick and dying showed the heart of a shepherd – a servant-leader – who ministered to God's flock in the name of Jesus.

Eternal rest grant unto your servant, James, O Lord, and may perpetual light shine upon him.

ACTIVE PARISHIONER STATUS

We receive many requests from parishioners to qualify for weddings here, or to be godparents or sponsors for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, and to rightfully enjoy the number of services offered at the Cathedral. Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an "active member" of the Cathedral Parish. Because of the nature of our congregation, having so many visitors, it is difficult to know everyone.

An "active member" of this parish is one who:

- Is properly registered and on the parish census
- Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days
 - Participates in parish activities when possible
- Uses the parish envelope system or contributes via Faith Direct While assessments of an inquirer's status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination.

Cathedral Early Learning Center (formerly Cathedral Parish Early Education Center) has remained opened through this time of COVID-

19 and is committed to ensuring a safe, clean, nurturing environment for children. We are now a year- round school, with open enrollment throughout the year based on availability, with minimal closures. Additionally, we were able to hold our full-time rates nearly the same as last year. We are accepting infants, one-year olds, two-year-olds, three-year-olds, and Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) children.

The VPK program begins August 11, and is designed to prepare children for kindergarten and build the foundation for their educational success. VPK is a free prekindergarten program for 4- and 5-year-olds who reside in Florida. Participating children must be 4 years of age on or before September 1. VPK is a daily program from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., and wraparound care is available beyond the VPK hours.

Lord Jesus, let me know myself and know Thee, and desire nothing save only Thee. Let me hate myself and love Thee. Let me do everything for the sake of Thee. Let me humble myself and exalt Thee. Let me think of nothing except Thee. Let me die to myself and live in Thee. Let me accept whatever happens as from Thee. Let me banish self and follow Thee, and ever desire to follow Thee. Let me fly from myself and take refuge in Thee, that I may deserve to be defended by Thee. Let me fear for myself, let me fear Thee, and let me be among those who are chosen by Thee. Let me distrust myself and put my trust in Thee. Let me be willing to obey for the sake of Thee. Let me cling to nothing save only to Thee, and let me be poor because of Thee. Look upon me, that I may love Thee. Call me that I may see Thee, and for ever enjoy Thee. Amen.

Although our nation has moved forward in a number of ways against racial discrimination, we have lost ground in others. Despite significant progress in civil law with regard to racism, societal realities indicate a need for further catechesis to facilitate conversion of hearts. Too many good and faithful Catholics remain unaware of the connection between institutional racism and the continued erosion of the sanctity of life. We are not finished with the work. The evil of racism festers in part because, as a nation, there has been very limited formal acknowledgement of the harm done to so many, no moment of atonement, no national process of reconciliation and, all too often a neglect of our history. Many of our institutions still harbor, and too many of our laws still sanction, practices that deny justice and equal access to certain groups of people. God demands more from us. We cannot, therefore, look upon the progress against racism in recent decades and conclude that our current situation meets the standard of justice. In fact, God demands what is right and just.


