


The Knights of Columbus invite all Catholic gentlemen 18 years and older to join the largest Catholic men's fraternal organization in the world. From the moment



#### **ACTIVE PARISHIONER STATUS**

We receive many requests from parishioners to qualify for weddings here, or to be godparents or sponsors for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, and to rightfully enjoy the number of services offered at the Cathedral. Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an "active member" of the Cathedral Parish. Because of the nature of our congregation, having so many visitors, it is difficult to know everyone.

#### An "active member" of this parish is one who:

- Is properly registered and on the parish census
- Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days
  - Participates in parish activities when possible
- Uses the parish envelope system or contributes via Faith Direct While assessments of an inquirer's status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination.




