



The Scrutinies

During the season of Lent, those who have been preparing to be initiated into the Life of Christ through the Church's Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist are in a final, 40-day journey to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. Those who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil are now called the Elect. Others who will be received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church are called, as are all of us who are already baptized, to continuing conversion of life.

Today the Elect celebrate the 1st Scrutiny with our parish community at the 9:00 a.m. Mass. These rites call upon the Elect to honestly look at their lives and find where sin still abounds and affects them. We, as the community of faith, are not only asked to pray for them, but also to realize our need to turn from sin: "Repent and believe in the Gospel" (Mk 1:15).

ST. JAMES THE GREATER AND THE CAMINO DE LA UNIDAD

The Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine is a founding member of the Alliance of Cathedrals and serves as the cornerstone of the Camino de la Unidad. It has been designated as the starting point for peregrinos (pilgrims) departing for the Camino de Santiago de Compostela (The Way of St. James in Spain), as well as the starting point for the Camino de la Unidad of the Americas (North, Central, and South America). This Statue of St. James was installed in a temporary position on July 25, 2022 (Feast of St. James the Greater, Apostle) in our Cathedral. The statue was specially carved from cedar and painted to strongly resemble the statue of St. James that sits on top of the Tree of Jesse in the Portico de la Gloria in the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela. There are plans to begin the construction of a special shrine to St. James in the West Courtyard of the Cathedral Basilica, SAINT JAMES, PRAY FOR US.

RECTORY RENOVATION UPDATE







FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

his week's FAQs focus on how the Cathedral's A Blessed Past, A Building for the Future Capital Campaign will raise the funds necessary for the rectory renovations.

As the seat of the diocese and Bishop Pohlmeier's part-time home, will the Diocese of St. Augustine contribute to this campaign?

The diocese recognizes the significance of the Cathedral Parish both within the Diocese of St. Augustine and as part of our national Catholic history. While Bishop Pohlmeier resides in Jacksonville to be close to the chancery offices, he visits the Cathedral rectory several times a month, often with friends or family. Given the important relationship the Cathedral Parish has within the Diocese of St. Augustine, we are hopeful the diocese will join our parishioners in offering a financial investment toward this important project.

How can I participate? Can I pledge over time?

Our campaign offers a wide range of gift opportunities to participate at all levels. You may choose a plan that provides you with flexibility and time to complete the payment of your pledge. Since our needs are urgent, we encourage you to complete your pledge within the three-year pledge period.

How was a pledge amount determined?

We base our "requested amounts" on past giving history and answers given in the planning study. We ask that you consider a gift above your normal support.

Who will leadership ask to support the A Blessed Past, A Building for the Future campaign?

We will ask all parishioners and visitors to consider a campaign commitment. In addition, we will coordinate with the Diocese of St. Augustine to approach potential donors outside of the parish.

How will the A Blessed Past, A Building for the Future campaign affect parish offertory?

In the short term, we expect offertory giving to remain constant. Through the effort, volunteers will ask parishioners to make pledges beyond their regular giving. We will not ask parishioners to diminish their offertory support but to consider a commitment above their normal tithe. In the long term, similar campaigns have led to increases in weekly giving by raising the sights of parishioners and their commitment to the church.






