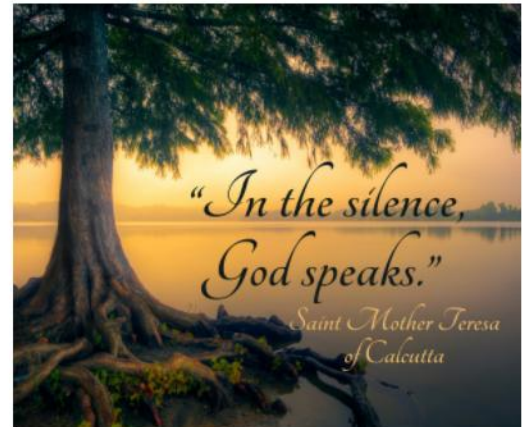
FREE PARKING SHUTTLE FOR 5 P.M. MASSES

ST. JAMES THE GREATER AND THE CAMINO DE LA UNIDAD

The Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine is a founding member of the Alliance of Cathedrals and serves as the cornerstone of the *Camino de la Unidad*. It has been designated as the starting point for peregrinos (pilgrims) departing for the Camino de Santiago de Compostela (The Way of St. James in Spain), as well as the starting point for the Camino de la Unidad of the Americas (North, Central, and South America). This Statue of St. James was installed in a temporary position on July 25, 2022 (Feast of St. James the Greater, Apostle) in our Cathedral. The statue was specially carved from cedar and painted to strongly resemble the statue of St. James that sits on top of the Tree of Jesse in the Portico de la Gloria in the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela. There are plans to begin the construction of a special shrine to St. James in the West Courtyard of the Cathedral Basilica. **SAINT JAMES, PRAY FOR US.**

Easter Sunday Morning's Gospel: John 20:1-9

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb
 early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone
 removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to
 the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken
 the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So
 Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They
 both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at
 the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did
 not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the
 tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered
 his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place.

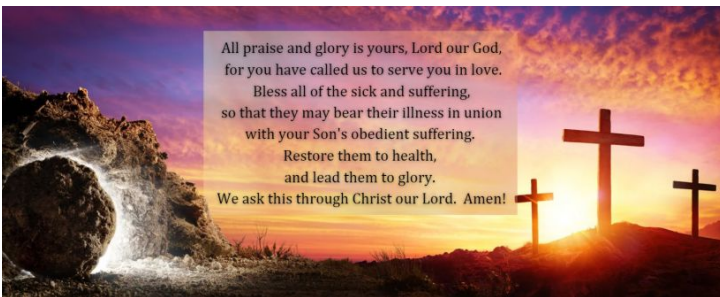
