



This is the hour of great mercy. In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion." - Jesus to St. Faustina, Diary 1320

"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy." - Jesus to St. Faustina, Diary 699





RECTORY RENOVATION UPDATE



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

After just a few weeks, the Cathedral's *A Blessed Past, A Building for the Future* Capital Campaign has hit an exciting milestone. After Easter, we officially surpassed the **\$1M** mark. Our next goal post is \$2.1M or the Father Camps Goal. At that point, we will have the funds required to upgrade the rectory's electrical and plumbing systems, restore all 75 windows to help with energy efficiency and noise, and make the rectory more accessible with wider doorways and bathrooms that meet ADA standards.


