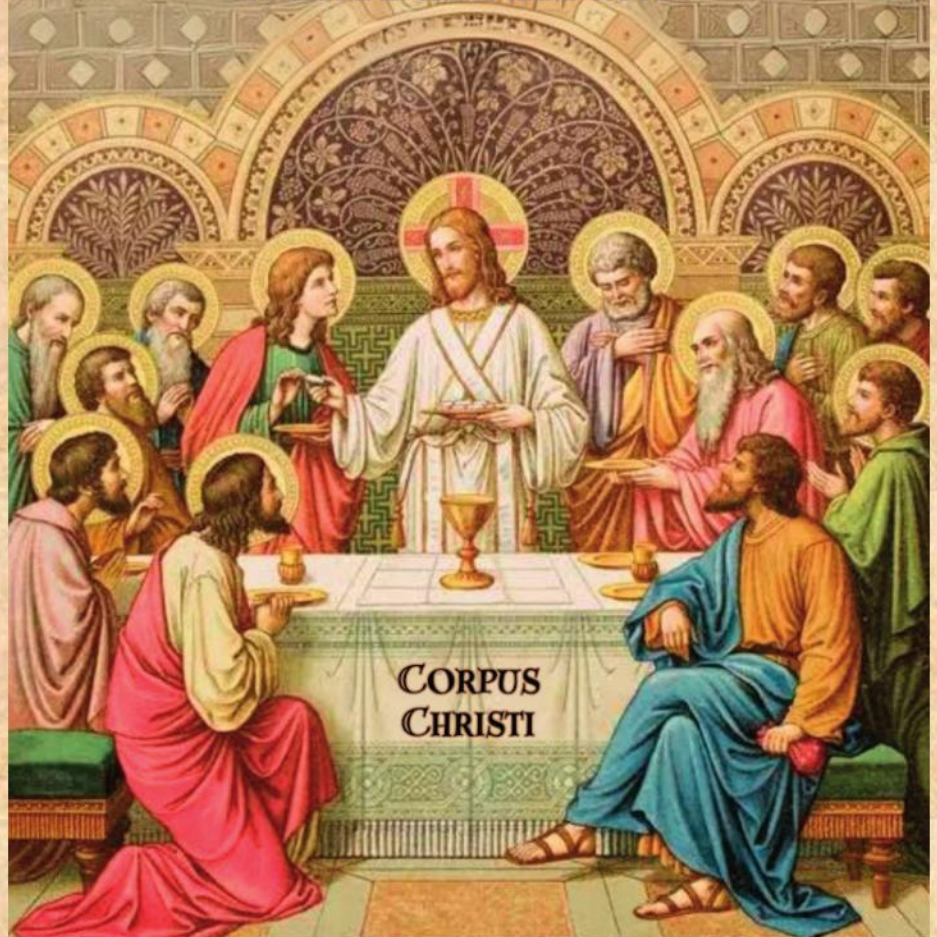

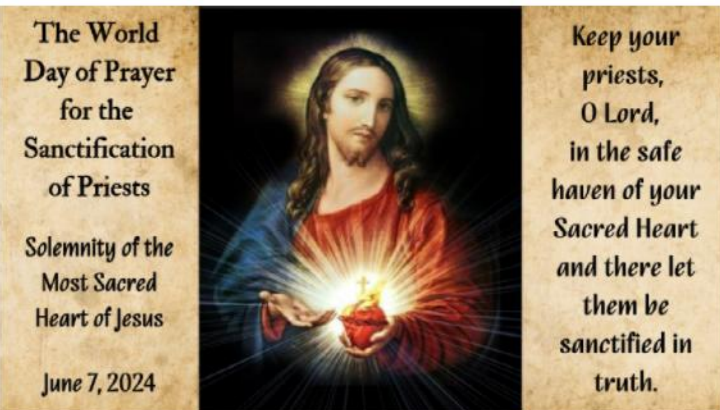

**Prepare for Hurricane Season**

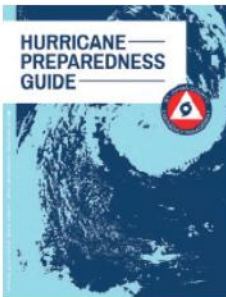
Many thanks to St. Johns County Emergency Management (SJCEM) Deputy Director- Ms. Kelly Wilson who gave an informative briefing guiding us through expectations if a hurricane affects our area. At our May social, she explained the difference between a watch and a warning: a simple comparison is a *watch* is like all the ingredients needed to make cookies and a *warning* is we're eating the cookies. She announced the National Weather Service is coming out with a new way to let people know about their storm risk to replace the hurricane cone map. This should launch in August. A warning is issued 36 hours in advance of the anticipated storm.



Ms. Wilson's three main suggestions for hurricane preparation are:

1. Have a disaster plan – and start now!
2. Know your flood zone and evacuation routes.
3. Have an emergency supply kit including at least a week's amount of medicine.

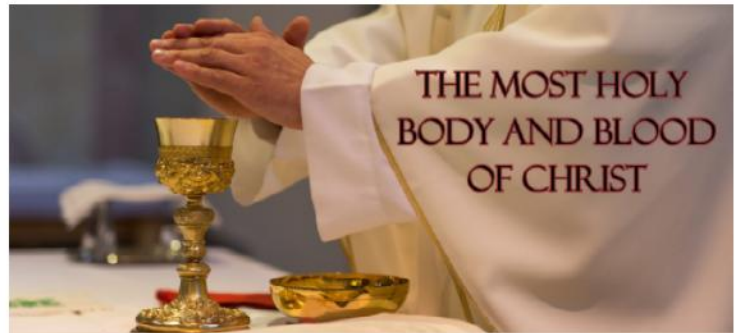


In our area, storm surge, flooding, and power outages are big concerns. She talked about the necessity of getting flood insurance based on what zone you live in.

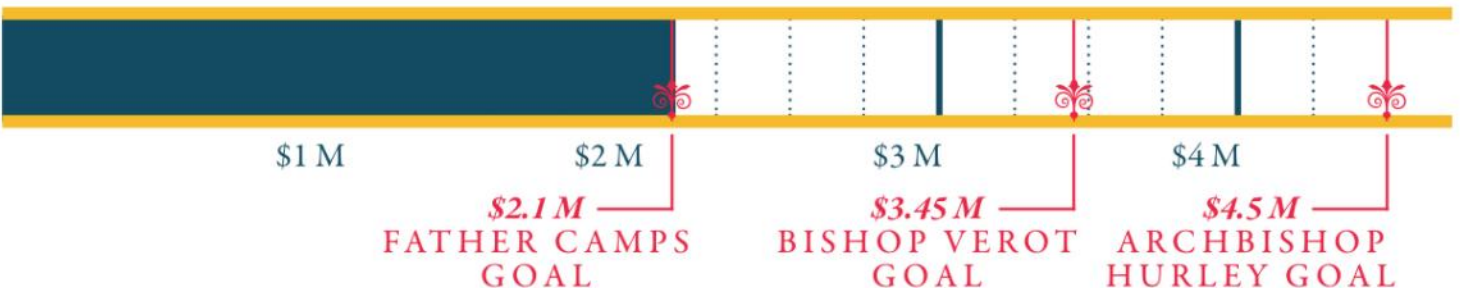
