News from the Cathedral Basilica Pastoral Council February 2026

The Angel Tree

The Angel Tree was re-introduced in December 2025 in order to make Christmas brighter for needy families in our Parish, St. Johns County and Palatka. The Council worked with Catholic Charities, who provided a list of needy families. On November 29th & 30th, Cathedral Parish families picked Angels from the two Christmas Trees and delivered their gifts on December 7th & 8th or December 13th & 14th. A total of 40 families and 75 children received gifts on Christmas morning, thanks to the outstanding generosity of our Cathedral parishioners!

Cathedral Ministry Fair

On January 25th, The Cathedral Pastoral Council sponsored a Ministry Fair, choosing to limit it to Parish Ministries. A total of 32 Parish Ministries were represented and 35 Ministry Leaders were in attendance. The Council had voted to include the 9am Mass, 11am Mass and the 5pm Mass. The 9am and 11am Masses filled the Rectory Courtyard, but following the 5pm Mass, there were fewer than 10 people. A total of 69 parishioners signed up to join a Parish Ministry! Ministry leaders let us know that they really enjoyed the opportunity for fellowship with one another!

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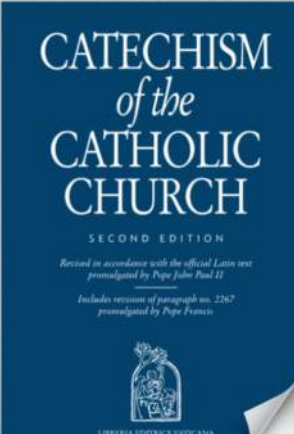
