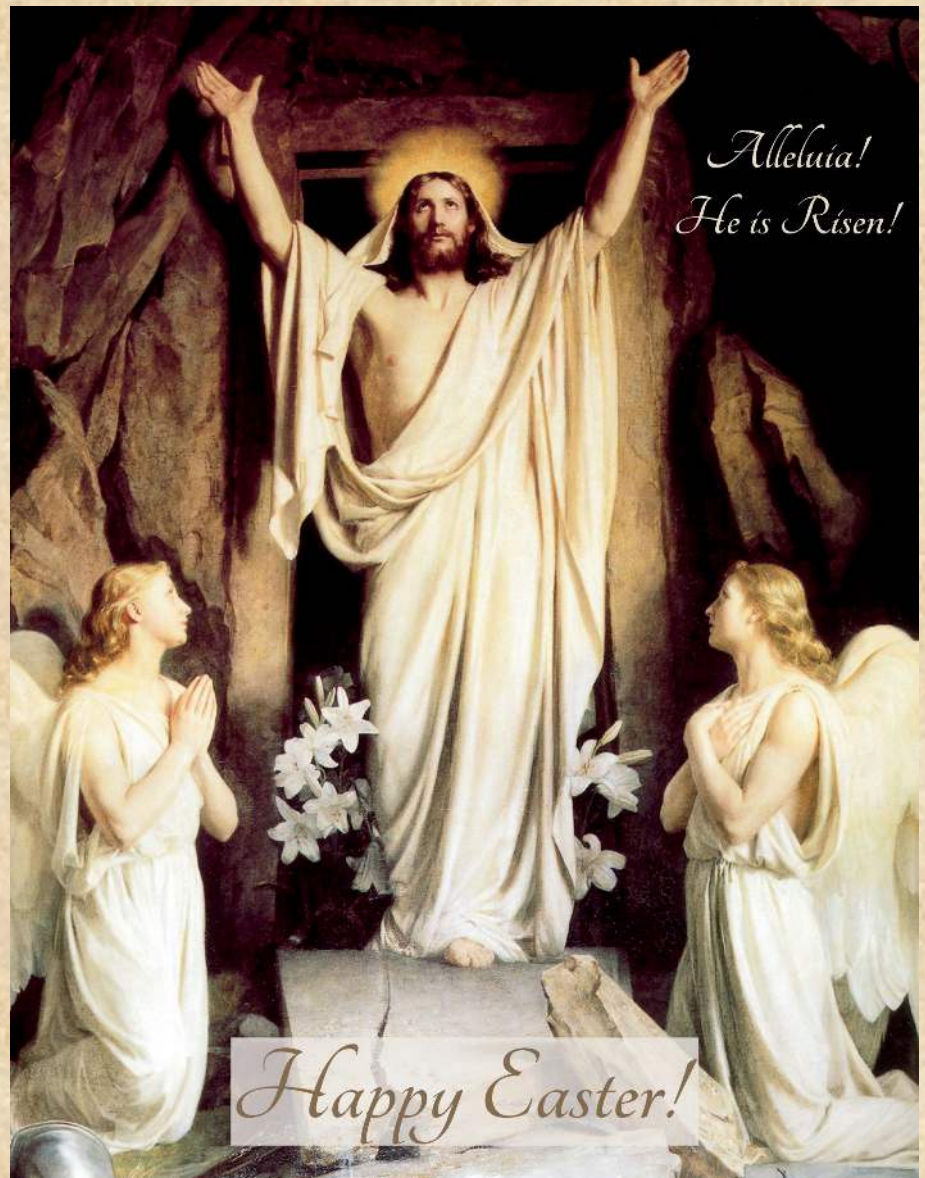

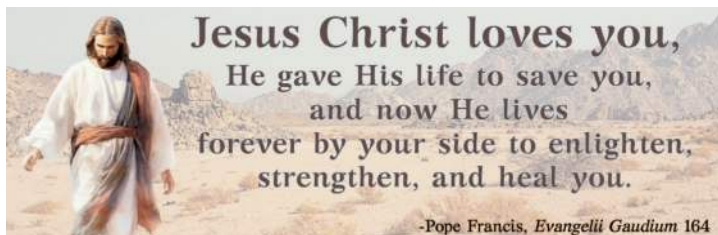

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

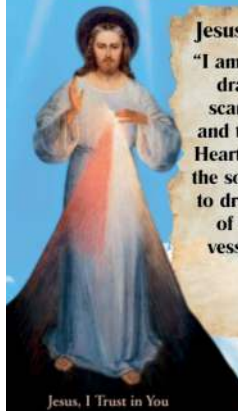

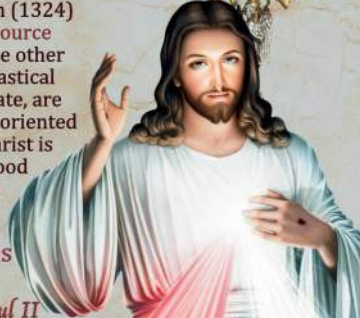
IN THE BLESSED SACRAMENT CHAPEL OF THE CATHEDRAL
