CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

New revision of number 2267 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church on the death penalty- Rescriptum "ex Audientia SS.mi", 02.08.2018

The death penalty

2267. Recourse to the death penalty on the part of legitimate authority, following a fair trial, was long considered an appropriate response to the gravity of certain crimes and an acceptable, albeit extreme, means of safeguarding the common good.

Today, however, there is an increasing awareness that the dignity of the person is not lost even after the commission of very serious crimes. In addition, a new understanding has emerged of the significance of penal sanctions imposed by the state. Lastly, more effective systems of detention have been developed, which ensure the due protection of citizens but, at the same time, do not definitively deprive the guilty of the possibility of redemption.

Consequently, the Church teaches, in the light of the Gospel, that "the death penalty is inadmissible because it is an attack on the inviolability and dignity of the person".[1] and she works with determination for its abolition worldwide.

Prayer Vigil at Florida State Prison — September 29, 2026

Florida is scheduled to carry out another execution on Tuesday, September 29, at 6:00 p.m. Catholics and others who believe in the dignity of human life are invited to gather across from Florida State Prison in Raiford for a peaceful prayer vigil.

The prayer service begins at 5:30 p.m. and concludes shortly after the scheduled execution, usually by 6:30 p.m.

As Catholics, we believe in the dignity of every human life, from conception to natural death. We remember and pray for victims of violence and their families while also witnessing that society can be protected without taking another human life.

Please consider joining Catholics from throughout Florida as we pray for victims, their families, those facing execution, correctional officers and staff, and for an end to the use of the death penalty.

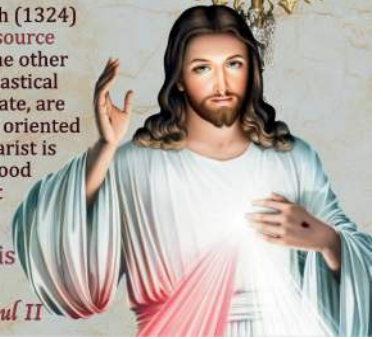
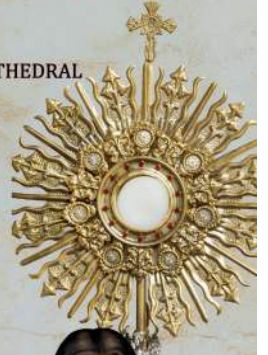
